Candidates will take a placement test in basic math and reading skills during the orientation as well as fill out an application. A TABE score of 10.0 in reading and a 9.0 in math is required for the EMM program. High School Diploma or High School Equivalency (HSE) is required. You must have a valid NYS Drivers' License and be eligible to obtain a CDL Class B permit.
