

Women, Infants and Children (WIC) is a federally funded program which supports pregnant women, post-partum women, breast feeding women, infants and children up to age 5.

Participant's receive nutrition education. They are provided with a food package (commonly referred to as eWIC card) that is tailored to the participant's needs, breastfeeding assistance, peer support and referrals to other programs. During summer months, participants also receive farmer market vouchers.

- \* They may automatically qualify if the client already receives SNAP, TANF and/or Medicaid.
- \* Foster Parent or any legal guardian can sign a child up for WIC.
