A pharmacy technician is the assistant to the pharmacist in a variety of settings including Retail Pharmacy, Hospital Pharmacy, the Insurance industry and the Pharmaceutical Sales industry. Offshoots include working with Electronic Medical Records and IT opportunities within large hospital organizations. It is the job of the pharmacy technician to ensure that the pharmacy operates efficiently and safely. The ideal candidate will be dependable, detail oriented, and trustworthy. A Licensed Pharmacy Technician is expected to be mature, have good communications skills, and be able to cooperate with a pharmacy team. Some aptitude in math is required as well as the ability to prioritize tasks. Computer skills are required and the ability to type a plus. A High School Diploma or GED is required for the **Pharmacy Technician Certification Exam \$129.00 (PTCB) www.ptcb.org**.
